



## **TERMS OF REFERENCE**

COMMITTEE	BREAST ACCESS AND MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE (BAMC)
PURPOSE	The Committee will be responsible for decision making, strategy setting, determining access and adhering to the scheduled funding agreement(s) deliverables of the Breast Screen Reader Assessment Strategy (BREAST).
TERMS OF REFERENCE	The Committee will focus on how BREAST generated data can be optimised in terms of access, reach, and impact upon research and clinical practice in Australia and abroad.
2014/01	<ul> <li>The tasks of the BAMC are to: <ul> <li>a) Develop a criteria for assessing and selecting research applications* for access to BREAST data,</li> <li>b) Assess and respond to applications and make recommendations based on assessment criteria,</li> <li>c) Review and monitor usage of BREAST data on an ongoing basis,</li> <li>d) Assess the quality and impact of the BREAST programme, and</li> <li>e) Inform the programme's progression consistent with funding agreement milestones and deliverables.</li> </ul> </li> <li>*Applications will be judged on merit, importance and relevance to laboratory equipment, and scored with predetermined criteria. Any permission granted will be subject to conditions such as appropriate ethics clearance and acknowledgement of funding bodies in any publication or presentation. The overall aim will be that as many relevant projects to Breast Cancer research as possible will be accommodated (as long as the research requires the laboratory), following prioritisation of applications.</li> </ul>
